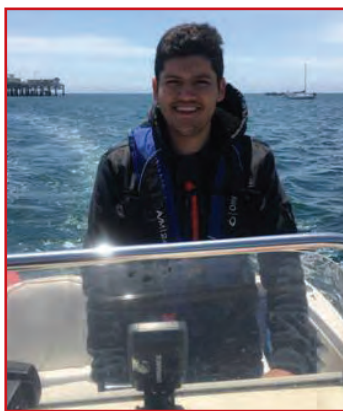

Thank you **Bill Dyer** and **Rod Valine** who have signed up to run the Chase Boat for the June ocean races! Please contact me if you are interested in assisting with the Chase Boat.

I am pleased to report that the SLYC Chase Boat is running

well. Thanks again to **Barry Stewart** for assisting with the outboard engine maintenance. I last took the Chase Boat out for the May 20th Ocean races. Even though the racing got cancelled, we took the opportunity to test the engine and the engine ran very well at low, medium or high speeds. Thanks to my crewman **Hector Rodriguez** for coming out with me and learning how to run the Chase Boat.

I was able to have the SLYC Chase Boat inspected by the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary during the May 20th Port San Luis Safe Boating Day event.

The Auxiliary performed a free Vessel Safety Check (VSC) of the boat’s systems and safety equipment. I’m happy to report we passed and the SLYC Chase Boat was issued a 2018 decal. There is no cost for this service which only takes about 20 minutes and the decal informs the Harbor Patrol, Coast Guard, Sheriff and other law-enforcement that you are in full compliance with Federal and State boating laws. I wanted to share information about the New California Boater Card! Starting on January 1, 2018, the mandatory boating safety education law went into effect and will phase in by age. If you operate any type of motorized vessel on California waterways (including powered sailboats), you will be required to pass an approved boating safety examination and carry a lifetime California Boater Card.

The cost of the Boater Card is \$10. The cost for the online, home study or classroom courses range in price from Free to \$40.

When will operators be required to have a Boater Card?

- January 1, 2018 Persons 20 years of age or younger
- January 1, 2019 Persons 25 years of age or younger
- January 1, 2020 Persons 35 years of age or younger
- January 1, 2021 Persons 40 years of age or younger
- January 1, 2022 Persons 45 years of age or younger
- January 1, 2023 Persons 50 years of age or younger
- January 1, 2024 Persons 60 years of age or younger
- January 1, 2025 All persons regardless of age

There are a few exemptions for those with a captain/commercial fishing license, those operating a rental vessel or those who reside outside California and temporarily operate a vessel in California. The California Division of Boating and Waterway offers a free home study/eBook and will mail you a 60 question exam packet. For more information please go to the website: <https://tinyurl.com/yd4fmmmda>.

I am glad to announce that the US Coast Guard Auxiliary Morro Bay Flotilla 07-61 is sponsoring the “About Boating Safely” course on Saturday, June 16, 2018 at Port San Luis from 8 am to 5 pm. Topics include: Introduction to Boating, Boating Law, Boat Safety Equipment, Safe Boating, Navigation, Boating Problems, Trailering, Storing and Protecting Your Boat, Hunting and Fishing, Water-Sking and River Boating. I understand that at the end of classroom presentation, students will be given the exam to obtain the California Boater Card and those who pass will be given a temporary Boater Card.

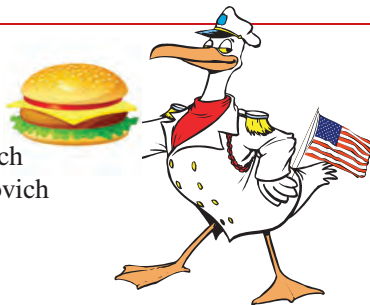

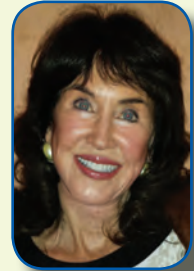
