Membership

Thank you for your interest in membership in the San Luis Yacht Club in 2025.

Membership and applications for membership are defined in our Club By-Laws.

Chapter I. Membership

Section I. A membership is an individual or a couple as defined by marriage or a domestic partnership.

Section VIII. Applications for membership shall be in writing in accordance with procedure(s) established by the Board of Directors.

The current membership application procedure for 2025 is as follows:

- 1. Applicants must have 2 sponsors.
- 2. Sponsors (Honorary or Flag members) must be Members in Good Standing, members for 3 or more years and one of the two sponsors must have known the applicant a minimum of one year. Sponsors must be able to attest to the applicant's volunteerism, boating experience, and participation if applicable in Club activities as a guest.
- 3. Sponsors must assist with new member mentoring and the required 6 board approved onboarding (OB) events.
- 4. Members can sponsor only one applicant per year.
- 5. All applicants must attend one of the orientation sessions with at least one of their two required Sponsors. If the applicants are married, both spouses must attend an orientation session. Application forms will be distributed electronically at the end of two orientation sessions – January 16, 2025 and January 21, 2025. Applicants and sponsors need to attend only one of the two meetings. There will be no alternative dates for orientation meetings.
- 6. Only membership applications from applicants who attended an orientation session and received an electronic copy will be accepted.
- 7. Membership applications must be submitted electronically as one PDF and include both the Sponsor applications and be received no later than 8 PM, February 7, 2025 by the Junior Staff Commodore jstaffcommodore@slyc.org. An email will be sent to applicants confirming receipt of the application.

Frequently asked questions:

What happens after I submit my application?

The membership committee will perform an initial review of each application to verify:

- The application packet submitted on time
- Applicant orientation meeting attendance confirmed
- Application is accompanied by two sponsorship forms signed by current flag or honorary members who meet the criteria for sponsors
- Applications not meeting any of the above requirements will not be considered and the applicant and the sponsors will be notified
- The membership committee will determine applicants who will be invited for an interview. Applicants selected for an interview will be contacted on <u>Sunday</u>
 <u>February 16, 2025</u> by with an interview time on <u>Saturday February 22, 2025</u>, Interviews are in person at the Club
- <u>Thursday March 6, 2025</u>, Membership Chair forwards applicants selected for membership to the Board for approval.
- All applicants notified of the status of their application

How many openings will there be in 2025?

The short answer is we do not know. Members must pay their dues by December 31 to avoid a late fee, and they have until January 31 to pay or be removed from the Club. Membership is capped at 200 members.

Why is the process so short?

The goal is to select new members in time so that they can be introduced at the Club's annual Opening Day Ceremony in April.

Do I need a sponsor?

Yes. Each applicant must be sponsored by two (2) SLYC Flag or Honorary members.

Where can I get a Membership Application form and Membership Sponsorship forms? Membership application forms and Sponsorship forms will be available only to those applicants (and at least one sponsor) who attend one of four orientation meetings. Application forms will be not accepted from applicants who have not attended one of the scheduled Orientation Meetings.

Information for the 2025 membership drive besides this informational sheet posted at the club - <u>will be</u> <u>published</u> in the October Foghorn, in various Scuttlebutts and a link has been posted on our club's web page.

New Membership information / Timeline and Dates:

The 2025 New Member selection committee will consist of **Bob Hurd** rbrthurd@gmail.com / 805.550.9071 text as the Committee membership chair and five flag members TBD.

Club applications will only be available at the in-person **application meetings**. Jan 16 & Jan 21 @6:30pm. <u>Bring</u> <u>your laptop</u> to download the application or sponsor form. (Forms will be posted only the night of the 2 meetings)

Due to a 200 Flag member cap – Openings for new members are unknown until after the club's membership dues payment for 2025 closes on 12/31/2024. Although were projecting 4-6 openings. The board will be confirming membership openings at the February 6, 2025, Board meeting.

Due to club membership timeline constraints, the time frame process is tight from the application stage to the interview time to meet the March board approval of new members. With a short timeline the following two application meeting dates are scheduled **for Thursday Jan 16 & Tuesday Jan 21, 2025, at 6:30 pm at the SLYC. Applicants & sponsors only attend one of the two meetings.** Application/sponsor forms to be downloaded at the meeting (s)

Those **interested in becoming a member or have questions** - On the following dates please give Commodore B. Hurd, 2025 membership chair, a heads up in advance via email or text, to be available at the club's evening social events to informally answer questions / discuss the applicant process on the following dates **10/18**, **11/15**, **& 12/6**.

FYI - New members are not required to attend any of these 3 listed informational nights. Please pre contact Commodore, Bob Hurd 2025 membership chair if you have a potential applicant prior to coming to the dates listed

Reminder the <u>new member process & requirements changed</u> per bylaws in 2023: & in 2024 applications went paperless

- 1. New members to apply must have 2 sponsors, one of the two sponsors will need to have known the applicant for a minimum of 1 year. Note: Sponsors cannot recommend new members until after their 3rd year of membership.
- 2. Both sponsors must be <u>willing to help mentor the new member with the required 6 onboarding events</u> to complete during their probationary flag membership year, not the 2 required service time commitments.
- 3. Sponsors (Honorary or Flag members) must be Members in Good Standing, club members for 3 or more years and one of the two sponsors must have known the applicant a minimum of one year and must be able to attest to the applicant's volunteerism, boating experience, and participation if applicable in Club activities as a guest, and a willingness to assist with the new member mentoring / and the required 6 board approved onboarding (OB) events. (OB list to be provided to new members at the orientation meeting)

- 4. Members can sponsor only one applicant per year. (refer to item 3)
- 5. New members are probationary Flag members their first-year contingent on completing the 6-onboarding events requirement prior to November 6, 2025. (JSC will monitor progress during the probationary period)
- 6. Two application meetings are scheduled at the club applicants with sponsors attend only 1 of the 2 meeting dates.
- 7. Applications provided only at the meeting note members/sponsors <u>bring a laptop</u> will need to download the forms while at the meetings scheduled for Jan 16 & 21 at the SLYC. (must attend one of them)
- 8. Perspective members, and spouse, must attend the application meeting with their sponsor(s). Bring a laptop

Friday socials October 18, November 15, & December 6 – **These are general interest talks** – **not required to attend** – sponsors please give Commodore Hurd, 2025 membership chair a heads up via email / text – to be available to meet potential applicants who have an interest in applying for membership. A laptop will be needed for the January meeting.

Thursday 1/16 and Tuesday 1/21/2025, Application Meetings at 6:30 pm at the SLYC. Applicants & Sponsors need to attend only one of the two meetings. (Application/sponsor forms to be downloaded at the meeting) Need Iaptop.

Friday 2/7/2025 by 8 pm, completed new member application from the applicants including their sponsors forms must be received as one PDF file 2/7/25, 8pm by Jr. Staff Commodore, Bob Hurd, 2025 membership chair.

Applications are to be send as **one PDF** attachment via email send to **Jr. Staff Commodore, membership chair Bob Hurd** rbrt@gmail.com **Note** - Jr Staff Commodore will confirm receipt of application to applicant.

Sunday 2/16/2025, applicants selected for an interview will be contacted by Jr. Staff Commodore (Bob Hurd) via email with an interview time slot.

Saturday 2/22/2025, Interviews scheduled at the club in person (Time to Be determined /10 am - 4 pm).

Thursday 3/6/2025, Membership chair forwards members selected to the SLYC board for approval. Note per bylaws approved in 2022, new members will be considered probational flag members their first year and must complete by 11/6/25 their 6 required onboarding events per a board approved plan listing of various events. Specific events TBD with the member & JSC, membership chair) in addition to their 2 required service time commitments.

Saturday 3/22/2025, 10:00 -12:30 PM at club – (check in 10 am / Brunch 10:30) A Required new member orientation meeting is scheduled for the new members selected (not sponsors). A brunch will be served / with a meet and greet social time with the flag officer team. In addition to the orientation to the club, new members' onboarding (OB) activities requirements will be discussed (a board approved designated listing of OB events will be provided). The OB <u>plan due April 30</u> to JSC– activities need to be completed prior to Nov 6, 2025. Members will also receive their club's name tags, card key access and a picture will be taken for the club directory. New members are required to pay their one-time initiation fee and SLYC annual dues at this event.

By Mid April – B.Hurd, will contact new members as a follow up specific to any questions / concerns to complete OB form.

Saturday 4/12/ 2025, Noon – projected date – 2025 club calendar not approved until Dec 2024. New members will be asked to attend – the 88^{Th} annual San Luis Yacht Club Opening Day held at the club so that they can be introduced by the Commodore to the membership, sponsors present would be nice but not required.
